PARENT GOVERNOR

The role of the governing board

The school's governing board is responsible for providing confident and strategic leadership, and creating robust accountability, oversight and assurance for the school's educational and financial performance. The board is passionate about education and committed to continuous improvement to ensure the best possible outcomes for our pupils.

The role of a parent governor

As a parent governor, you will work as a member of the board to ensure it effectively carries out the duties referred to above. You will also play a vital role in ensuring that the board is connected with, and is aware of the views of parents and the local community.

To be a parent governor you should have:

- A strong commitment to the role and to improving outcomes for children
- Good inter-personal skills, curiosity, and a willingness to learn and develop new skills
- The skills required to ensure the governing board delivers effective governance
- Sufficient time to undertake the role.

Governors are expected to:

- Attend meetings of the Governing Body and Committees to which they are appointed
- Contribute to governors' projects and initiatives as required
- Maintain confidentiality
- Commit to training
- Visit the school from time to time.

If we receive more than one application, a secret ballot will be carried out. I will inform you in due course if we need to do this.
