

English

This term the children will be learning about Quest and Adventure stories using the story of 'How to Find Gold'. We will be exploring dialogue and the rich illustrations as well as the characters and creating our own adventure story.

The focus for reading this term is to continue to find information in texts and then to infer from the texts we are reading by using a combination of what is in the reading and what we can think will happen or how other people are feeling.

Spellings patterns

Topic:

In Geography this term we will be developing our understanding of the continents and oceans. We will be using an atlas to locate them around the world and using ICT to research and find out facts.

Maths - Multiplication and Division, Statistics and Shape

Then we will identify and describe the properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes. Then compare and sort common 2-D and 3-D shapes and everyday objects.
