There will be no charge for children in KS1 - Reception / Yr1 and Yr2 as you are in receipt of Universal Infant Free School Meals, however to avoid wastage we do still require confirmation if your child will not be taking a Christmas Lunch.

If you have a child born between 1 September 2016 and 31 August 2017, then now is the time to apply for a place at our school for admission from September 2021 onwards. You must complete an application form that is available from the school admissions team of North Somerset Council.
