Dear Parents and Carers,

We mentioned to the children during assembly this morning that this Christmas would be very different for everyone this year. But as the second Sunday of Advent looms we all have to remember that one thing is still the same and that is the coming of our Lord and saviour who gives us all hope, even in the darkest of times.

Thank you to Years 4, 5 and 6 children who made Christmas cards for the elderly parishioners of St Joseph's church, who are housebound and self-isolating. I am sure they will really give some Christmas cheer to those in our community who are missing their church community.

Uniform

Thank you to all parents who have worked hard to maintain our school uniform code even when trying to add extra layers to cope with our open windows and extra ventilation.

However, can we please remind you about our current uniform code where a few items have begun to slip below our expected standards:

- Hair please make sure that hair is tidy and that all accessories should be **gold/navy**. Obviously for Christmas Jumper day and when specifically requested by teachers, festive items can be substituted!
- Long Hair if your child's hair is below the collar in length then it should be tied back neatly. We do have issues with nits and head-lice which are made worse if hair is not kept tidy.
- Nail Polish Children should not have painted nails at any time in school.
- Jewellery The only jewellery permitted in school are gold studs for earrings and a watch. No rings or bracelets should be worn.
- Shoes please make sure your child has suitable school shoes. Apart from PE days when trainers can be worn, trainers and boots should not be worn to school as they are not included in our uniform code.
- PE Kit Please make sure that your child has their Yellow PE shirt and blue shorts/joggers/leggings. They should wear their school jumper or cardigan as an extra layer please.

Christmas Cards

We do not want to stop children bringing in their Christmas cards for their friends but we are not doing sorting and delivery with the big post-box this year. Please can your child bring in their cards in a named bag/envelope so they can be 'quarantined' in class for 72 hours. We would be grateful if you could avoid licking the envelopes and go for the 'tuck-it-in' option!

While in Tier 3 we have been restricted from any form of public performance. We are currently in the process of videoing and recording performances and plays. These will all be made available on the Google classroom platform as we have done with Praise Assemblies.
