If your child is a baptised catholic please provide the school with the baptism certificate so we can take a copy. The next new parent open afternoon is Monday the 18th of November at 2.15pm please spread the word if you know anyone who has a pre-schooler.

You will be able to make appointments on e schools from 6pm on Friday the 4th of October. Please make sure you have your log in details. You will be informed of the times and dates on Friday the 11th of October.

Apply to the EU Settlement Scheme (settled and pre-settled status)

Overview If you're an EU, EEA or Swiss citizen, you and your family can apply to the EU Settlement Scheme to continue living in the UK after 30 June 2021. If your application is successful, you'll get either settled or pre-settled status.

The EEA includes the EU countries and also Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway.



You may be able to <u>stay in the UK without applying</u> - for example, if you're an Irish citizen or have indefinite leave to remain.

When you can apply - The EU Settlement Scheme is open. You can <u>apply now</u> if you meet the criteria. The deadline for applying is 30 June 2021.

Which status you get may depend on when you apply.

If the UK leaves the EU without a deal - You will need to be living in the UK before it leaves the EU to apply. The deadline for applying will be 31 December 2020.

Fees - It's free to apply to the scheme.

Please refer to the websites above for further information. It is our understanding that if you do need to apply, it is best to do it as soon as possible – ie: before the decision is made on 31^{st} October 2019.
