## Exceptionally, on Wednesday this week, Mass will be at 7pm, with rosary at 6.20pm.

**Pentecost Sunday** is on 31 May. On 30 May we will have a special Pentecost Vigil Mass at 8pm, while on Pentecost Sunday we will have a 'Praise Party' for our deanery at 8pm which will be an opportunity to pray and sing some uplifting hymns as we rejoice in the gift of Pentecost.

I am offering a **virtual retreat leading up to Pentecost**, which begins at 6pm on Monday. More details at josephfrancis.org/retreat

Bishop Declan has invited us to pray the rosary in a special way on Pentecost Sunday. As a Diocese we have had a request from Monsignor John Armitage, from the Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham, to participate in a May Rosary Mission on Pentecost Sunday (31<sup>st</sup> May). Each Diocese in England, Wales and Scotland has been allotted an hour in which the Rosary will be prayed either individually or in family groups. The hour allotted to Clifton is 1pm.
