Behaviour Code

We have a new code of behaviour which is centred around our vision and values. The children understand what is meant by expected and unexpected behaviour. If your child has appeared in the behaviour book 3 times during a 5 day rolling period they will receive a lunch time detention on a Friday. A letter will be sent home with your child to explain why they received the detention and asking for your support.
