English Power of Reading - This term we will be reading 'One Night Far From Here'. The children will be writing for different purposes including poetry, fiction and non-fiction., considering and evaluating viewpoints and participating in discussions, performances, role play, improvisations and debate about what has been read and their responses. Children will use spoken language to develop understanding through imagining, exploring ideas and discussing a range of vocabulary.

<u>Phonics -</u> We are now recapping and consolidating Phase 5. These are: ay, ou, ie, ea, oy, ir, ue, ue, aw, wh, ph, ew, oe, au, ey, a-e, e-e, ie. o-e. u-e. We will also be learning alternative pronunciations for i, o, c, g, u, ie, ow, ea, er, a, y, ch.

<u>Topic: (Geography) -</u> Children will be learning about the countries that make up the United Kingdom and finding them on a map. Children will learn that the capital of England is London as well as learning about the capitals of Wales, Scotland and Northern Treland

PE We will be developing our ball skills – throwing and catching large balls as well as playing mini games. We will then use our skills to play whole class attack and defending games such at mat-ball and benchball. If the weather is good we will also try some outdoor ball skills.

<u>RE – Lent</u>

Children will become more aware of the importance of Lent and why it is 40 days long (Temptation of Jesus). We will also look at the story of Zaccheus and Jesus. We will also be looking at art-work linked to Jesus and the Children. Before Holy week. we will look at the Jewish Faith.
