English

This term the children will be looking at various ways of written communication linked to the seaside. We will explore and create messages in bottles, postcards and letters. We will focus on ensuring our letter formation is accurate as well as punctuation and spelling using phonics. We will be enjoying texts linked to the seaside. The children will also be looking beyond 'phonics' towards spelling patterns in readiness for Year 2. Light House Keepers Lunch will be a focus this term.

Phonics

We are preparing for the Phonics Check which is the week commencing 10th June. After this we will be looking at spelling patterns.

Topic:

This term we will be looking at seaside comparisons. We will explore differences between now and 100 years ago at the seaside as well as comparing Weston super Mare to the Costa Del Sol!

<u>PE</u>

This term the children prepare for sports week. The children will be practising sprinting, sac race and egg and spoon. They will also be practising the field events. Sport week will be exciting with lots of new activities and experiences for the children.

RE - Pentecost and Sacraments

This unit invites pupils to deepen their knowledge of the Pentecost story and consider the symbolism of the story. Opportunities are provided to explore the nature of the symbolism. The nature of the disciples' response to Pentecost is explored.

Maths

The children will start the term revisiting place value to 100 and subtraction. We will then identify money, add and subtract different amounts and then solve problems. Finally we will learn about time. Children will learn o'clock and half past. They will sequence events in the day. In sports week the children will look at positioning (1st, 2nd, 3rd). All term we will be checking number bonds (to 20 and 100).

Science Seasons

In Science the children will identify and explore the seasons, their characteristics and how it affects our lives. We will also be looking at flowers and plants which are used in the summer as well as edible plants linked to healthy eating in Sports Week.

Music

Year 1 have music lessons with Mrs Page on a Wednesday.
