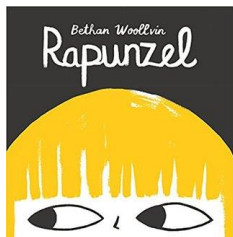

Revisit Holy Week & Stations of the Cross from end of Term 4
Easter - Further detail is provided for the account of the empty tomb. Thomas is introduced to help pupils understand that not all people responded to the resurrection of Jesus in the same way.
The accounts are found in the Gospels.
Pentecost and Mission - The nature of the promise made by Jesus is a key focus. An understanding of Pentecost as the birthday of the Church is developed. Links are also made between Confirmation and Pentecost.
