What a fantastic time the school has had in competitive school sports over the Autumn term. We have such a wide range of talent within the school with many of our children enhancing their skills by competing for our local sports clubs every weekend.

It would be lovely to individually mention every child who has achieved but our success has been so comprehensive I would need at least four pages.

Our Roll of Honour in Term 1 includes-

- 40 KS2 children representing the school in the Gordano Cross Country. Boys were 2nd overall and Girls were 3rd.
- 2 of our Athletes were selected to represent Team Somerset in the South West Cross Country Championships
- We sent a squad of Year 6 children who had not played competitive rugby before to represent the school in the Gordano Rugby Festival and they did superbly
- Our Year 4 Athletics Squad competed in the Gordano Indoor Athletics event. The Girls finished 1st and the Boys finished 2nd.
- Our Girls Football Squad finished Runners p in The Gordano Cluster event
- Our Boys Football Squad won the Gordano Cluster event
- Our Girls' Football Squad finished 3rd in the North Somerset Championship
- Our Boy's Football Squad finished Runners Up in the North Somerset Championship. They lost the finals on penalties but qualified for the Somerset Championship
- Two of our Year 5 boys have been selected to play football for North Somerset

I sure that I have missed one or two of our successes for which I can only apologise but I'm sure you will all agree that this list indicates the depth of sporting talent that we have within our wonderful school.
