At school we want staff and pupils to enjoy the sun safely. We will work with staff, pupils and parents to achieve this through:

EDUCATION

- All pupils will have at least one SunSmart lesson per year
- We will talk about how to be SunSmart in assemblies at the start of the summer term

PROTECTION

Shade:

- We have four playground shelters already in place
- We have bought picnic tables and these are located in shady areas of the playground
- There are canopies for the children to shelter under

Clothing:

- We have school sun hats that are available from School Togs, Nailsea. We would encourage children to wear wide brimmed sun hats if you provide your own
- The PTFA provide Reception children with a school sun hat at the beginning of the school year

Sunscreen:

- We cannot currently supply or apply sunscreen to pupils on a daily basis because of cost, allergies and intolerances
- Please apply a high factor sunscreen before your child comes to school in the morning
- If your child is old enough to apply their own sunscreen they may bring it to school (labelled with their name) in their bag, they may only apply it to themselves
