Mental Health Week

As many of you are aware children's mental health is in the news at the moment, we are all worried about the levels of anxiety amongst our young people in today's modern world. St Joseph's is very proud to be part of the Anna Freud 'Inspire' project led by Manchester University and funded by the DFE. There are only 260 schools in the country taking part in the study. Every day Years 4 and 5 are taking part in breathing and relaxation techniques to help them through the day and equip themselves in ways to dissipate worry. The whole of the school took part in a relaxation assembly during mental health week. Perhaps your child could teach you a few of the breathing techniques they have learnt.
